


Achieve@ARC

- Attend New Student Experience




ACHIEVE@ARC

- ***Program development underway: fall semester activities, communications, case management***



Below are some quick tips for the first week of classes and upcoming Achieve@ARC activities:

- **Fall Semester Starts:** The semester begins Saturday, August 25th—you're first day at ARC will be the first day of your scheduled classes.
- **"Achieve 411:"** Have questions? Drop by the Student Services *Connect Center* or outside the *Counseling Center* building to meet Achieve team staff who can help answer any questions you may have. We'll be handing out FREE bottled waters and snacks, too! Monday–Wednesday (August 27-29), 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- **Achieve Ice Cream Social:** Join us on Friday, September 7th from 12 noon to 1 pm for a FREE ice cream sundae and to meet your Achieve Success Team and other new students!

Tips for Your First Week at ARC:

- **Parking:** Make sure you purchase your parking permit before the first day of class.
 - Parking spots will be very hard to find—arrive at least 1 hour early during the first week of classes to make sure you're able to find a parking spot and get to class on time.
 - Make sure you park in Student Parking Lots and have your permit displayed correctly.
- **How to Find Your Classes:** Here's a link to the college's campus map... download or pick-up a copy at the Information Desk in the Administration building. Try to map out where your classes are and how to get there. http://www.arc.losrios.edu/About_ARC/ARC_Campus_Map.htm
 - Need help to find your classes? Staff in Student Services and the Connect Center can help!
- **Buy or rent your textbooks as soon as possible**—there are many options to do so, like the campus bookstore and online vendors, like Amazon. Just make sure you're getting the right edition.
- **Get organized**—use a calendar (we have free planners available in the Counseling Center or Connect Center or use a smart phone app) to plan your schedule of classes, study time, work and other obligations. Remember, for every hour of class time, professors expect 2 hours of study time.
- **Attending Class:** Do not miss the first day of class or you will be dropped! If you are on a wait list, make sure to get to class early and sit-up in the front of the class.
- **Stay Connected:** Remember to check your Los Rios email for the latest news and actions required from the Financial Aid Office and other campus programs. Your Los Rios email is the primary way the college communicates with students.
