### Members of this group are expected to:

- Serve as a liaison for a group, unit, or department
- Be a point of contact for undocu-students when needed
- Examine policies and protocols with UndocuScholar inclusive lens
- Participate in regular meetings to discuss the needs and resources of UndocuScholars
- Help make recommendations to the college administration and governing bodies

## **Functions (not limited to):**

- Assessment of financial resources and gaps for undocumented students
- Collaborate in the evaluation of campus services, including their accessibility and effectiveness, and the assessment of campus climate for undocumented students
- Develop an assessment of relevant campus policies related to undocumented students
- Provide recommendations to the president and executive team regarding key policy and service changes
- Collaborate with the executive team, in developing messaging to the campus community in relationship to undocumented announcements.
- Direct connection to LRCCD Undocu-Student Workgroup
- Increasing collaboration with outside private entities that can help with these issues
- Distribution of LRCCD funding towards the needs of undocumented students
- Contribute to the planning and overall activities centered on Undocumented students provided throughout ARC
