

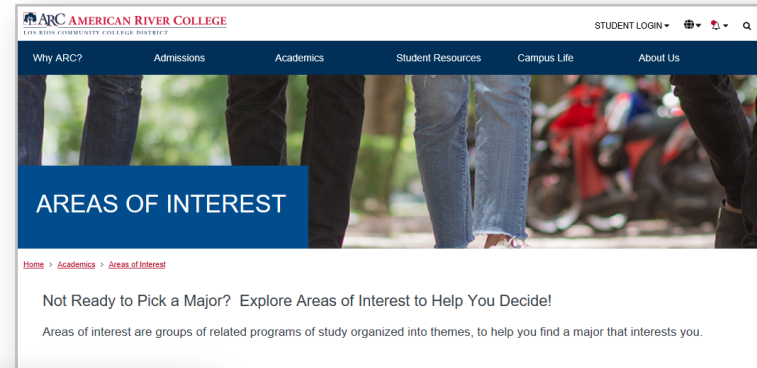

**EXPLANATION OF CATEGORIES**

Req	Required Core	A course that is required for this degree.
GE	General Education	A course that fulfills a specific general education requirement for this degree, which can be replaced with another course that meets the same requirement.
RE	Restricted Elective	A course selected from a list of elective courses specified for this degree in the catalog, which can be replaced with another course from the same list.
Elect	Elective	A degree-applicable course that is part of a degree roadmap to ensure that there is a total of at least 60 units, which is a requirement for an associate degree.
