Success Rate by Modality Report	Jen Laflam & Yuj Shimizu	<p>A member of the research team came to discuss the attached report concerning course success rates between online and on-ground classes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The timeframe was Spring '21, Fall '21, and Spring '22.</li><li>- Overall, course success rates were slightly higher for On-ground modalities vs Online modalities.</li><li>- Traditionally disproportionately impacted students success rates were higher for On-ground modalities vs Online modalities.</li><li>- Course success rates were higher for On-ground modalities vs Online modalities for all genders.</li><li>- More information and graphs can be found in the attached report.</li></ul>
